NOTED PIANIST TO GIVE RECITAL HERE NEXT WEEK

Xavier Scharwenka, the Celebrated Polish Pianist-Composer at Grand Opera House on Monday.

To the army of piano students and piano teachers in America, the revisit of Xaver Scharwenka is doubly welcome. Above all else, this famous composer-pianist is ever able to help the perplexed to grasp the meaning of the much abused word, "interpretation." He himself is rated with the few great versatile pianoforte virtuosi; of him it has been said: "He can roar with the lions and coo with the doves."

When Scharwenka plays Beethoven, one gets the genuine Teutonic atmosphere, with its depths and retrospection; when he plays Chopin, he is himself, a true son of Poland, the land of romance and beautiful women; when Scharwenka performs a Saint-Saens concerto, all the elegance and grace of the Gallic disciple are revealed. No one ever hesitates to accept the Scharwenka renditions as anything but authentic.

Scharwenka will give a recital in the Grand Opera House, Barrie, on Tuesday evening, October 15th, and will, doubtless, attract all the music-lovers of Barrie and surrounding territory.
